

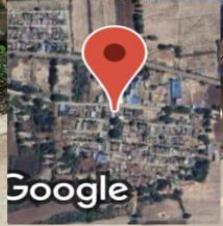


Report on Voting Awareness Program
