Patents: History of Patent protections; definition of patent; Object and salient features of patent; How to obtain patent; non-patentable inventions; Procedure for patent applications; Rights and obligations of patentee; Transfer of Patent Rights; Infringement of Patents; defences, Offences and Penalties and remedies; Patent Agents; Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights.

UNIT III

Trade Marks: Evolution of trade mark law; Object of trade mark; Features of good trade mark; Different forms of trade mark; concepts of trademark; Registrable and non-registrable marks; procedure; term of protection; Assignment and transmission; Infringement of trade mark and defences; Passing off; Offences penalties and remedies; overview of domain names and their protection; protection of trade secrets.

Indian Copyright Law: History of copyright and related rights; Nature and salient features of Copyright Act; Subject matter of copyright; Term of copyright; Author and ownership of copyright; Rights conferred by copyright; Assignment, transmission and relinquishment of copyright; Infringement of copyright; Remedies; Computer software and copyright protection; Overview of copyright protection on internet.


